- Learners become familiar with using a career decision making model, managing change, and the concept of lifelong learning

- group discussions
- reflective tasks
- individual online research

Work Readiness Level 2

What will I learn?

- skills in teamwork, problem solving, communication, planning and organisation, decision making, numeracy for work, and information technology
- Project management through a major 10-week project
- job search skills and techniques
- about recruitment and selection processes
- about workers' rights and responsibilities
- about Occupational Health and Safety

How will I learn and be assessed?

- major entrepreneurial project during Term 3
- comprehensive internal assessment schedule

Other

- complements VET courses by teaching valuable employability skills
- gain literacy, numeracy and ICT standards on successful completion
- cannot be studied in conjunction with Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways

Applied Capability Qualifications Level 2

What will I learn?

- aligned with employability skills and real-world contexts
- Each qualification is at TASC Level 2 complexity and, upon successful completion, a student's qualification will be recognised by TASC and allocated two TCE credit points
- The qualifications are asynchronous and self-paced and are nominally 20 hours in size

How will I learn and be assessed?

- group discussions
- investigation projects
- individual online research
- practical tasks

FSK20119 Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways

What will I learn?

- opportunities to explore pathways in a variety of fields to develop personal strengths and find out how this can lead to employment
- workers' rights and responsibilities
- Occupational Health and Safety
- recruitment and selection processes
- employability skills such as teamwork, flexibility and leadership
- to improve reading, writing, ICT and numeracy skills
- how to develop communication skills for the workplace
- how to prepare a resume

How will I learn and be assessed?

- practical tasks
- written assessments
- oral presentations
- all designed to evaluate your ability to apply learned skills in workplace scenarios

Other

- optional short courses such as Responsible Service of Alcohol and First Aid
- a pathway to further study in industry-specific programs or employment
- a good subject for Year 11 which may lead to a specialised VET course in Year 12

DEF10117 Certificate I in Defence Skills

What will I learn?

- about the Australian Defence Force (ADF)
- workplace skills including communication, workplace health and safety, and teamwork
- how to apply for positions in the ADF and other service-based professions

How will I learn and be assessed?

- practical projects
- teamwork activities
- skill-based assessments
