To receive an ATAR (for university entrance) you need: - To attain the TCE - Obtain an SA (Satisfactory Achievement) Award or higher in at least 4 (preferably five) TASC Level 3 or 4 courses. - Complete at least three TASC Level 3 or 4 courses in Year 12.
